### ***Improvements in the Park***

The soft sand at the playground will provide some protection for children who fall, but it is not a perfect safety solution. Also, the sand will be raked regularly, and we have mixed special salt into it as a disinfectant, but no public park can ever be completely safe or sterile. Children therefore need to be closely supervised - especially the little ones. Pet owners are responsible for keeping their pets out of the sandpit.
